

CARPET End User License Agreement (EULA)

This End User License Agreement (the "Agreement") is a legal agreement between you (either an individual or a single entity, the "Licensee") and Nederlandse Organisatie voor toegepast-natuurwetenschappelijk Onderzoek TNO ("TNO") for the CARPET (Computer Aided Radar Performance Evaluation Tool) software product (the "Software") and the accompanying manual (the "Manual").

1 License key

The use of the Software requires a license key, which will be provided by TNO for each license separately after the license fee has been paid. The license key is only valid for a pre-defined license period (the "License Period").

2 License Grant

TNO grants to Licensee under this Agreement for the time of the License Period a limited, revocable, non-exclusive, non-sublicensable and non-transferable license to use and display this copy of the Software as long as LICENSEE has paid the license fee and complies with the terms of this Agreement.

3 Ownership

The Software is licensed, not sold. TNO retains all rights, title and ownership of the Software and Manual and all intellectual property rights therein, except for the Third-Party Components identified below.

4 Use Restrictions

You may not:

- Modify, adapt, translate, reverse engineer, decompile, disassemble or create derivative works of the Software or the Manual.
- Remove any proprietary notices or labels on the Software or the Manual.
- Transfer, sublicense, rent, lease or lend the Software to any third party.
- Use the Software in any way not expressly permitted by this Agreement.

5 No Warranty

The Software and Manual are provided "AS IS", without warranty of any kind, express or implied. Further, TNO does not warrant, guarantee or make any representations regarding the use, or the results of the use, of the Software or the Manual in terms of correctness, accuracy, reliability or otherwise. The entire risk as to the results and performance of the Software is assumed by Licensee. No oral or written information or advice given by TNO or its authorized representatives shall create a warranty or in any way increase the scope of any warranty.

6 Disclaimer of Liability

TNO disclaims all liability for direct, indirect, incidental, special or consequential damages, including lost profits, resulting from use of the Software and Manual, including all technical descriptions, equations and procedures therein, even if TNO has been advised of the possibility of such damage. In any event, the liability of TNO in connection with the Software and Manual will be limited to the amount paid for the license, if any.
